The Project

Higgins Partnerships has formed a development partnership with Hillingdon Council to jointly deliver the regeneration of Hayes Town Centre Estate and Avondale Drive Estate.



The new homes we are building

Social Rent

7 one bedroom homes 16 two bedroom homes 5 three bedroom homes 2 four bedroom homes

We will start to formally allocate new homes early Summer. Allocations will be carried out in accordance with the council Social Housing Allocation Policy and Local Lettings Plan. The new homes are planned to be complete by late Summer 2025.

Car parking for residents

As the redevelopment progresses, we have demolished the car parking cages and have constructed a temporary car park located between Glenister House and Fitzgerald House.

Please refer to the image below. This has provided enough parking for existing residents. We have also provided residents with permits.

Longer term we will create parking spaces that will be positioned on the new estate roads and within podium car parks, depending on where your new home is located on the new development. We will provide further information as the development unfolds.



We are currently reviewing the community activity timetables for Avondale Drive and once they have been agreed with the Resident Engagement Panel (REP), we will provide a link on the next newsletter issue, which will allow you to view the timetables on the HI! website.

How new homes will be allocated?

Early Summer we will be contacting all residents with the right to return to the estate and those of you living in the Phase 2 and Phase 3 areas to arrange an appointment to discuss your requirements and allocate the new homes being built. We will make sure that you are allocated a home that fits your housing need which is assessed in line with the council's Social Housing Allocation Policy and Local Lettings Policy.

Priority bidding - How the system works?

If you would prefer to move off the estate, you will be given priority banding on the council choice based letting systems six months before your move. You will be able to bid for properties that you are interested in across the borough.

For residents taking a new home on the estate we will take into consideration your preferences in terms of location, floor level and neighbours as part of our commitments.

Leaseholders

We are working closely with leaseholders and to date have purchased several resident and investor held leaseholders' homes. Resident leaseholders who choose to remain on the regenerated estate can buy one of the new homes being built in phase one.

The affordable buying options available to resident leaseholders are:

- Shared equity
- Shared ownership

A resident leaseholder may of course buy a new property on the regenerated estate outright.

Alternatively, you may be looking to sell your property to the council and buy an onward property either in or outside of the borough on the open market.

We would also like to hear from investor landlords that are ready to sell their property to the council. If this is the case and you and can provide your property with vacant possession, please contact us.
