The new homes we are building

As you know, we will be providing the new affordable homes based on housing need which we captured through the housing verification forms completed with you last year.

At Hayes Town Centre we will be building:

Social Rent Shared Equity 18 one bedroom homes 5 one bedroom homes 28 two bedroom homes 9 two bedroom homes 11 three bedroom homes 5 three bedroom homes 4 four bedroom homes

We will start to formally allocate new homes in late Spring. Allocations will be carried out in a fair consistent way according to the council's Social Housing Allocation Policy and Local Lettings Plan. The new homes will complete by Summer 2025.
